

Initial Comparison of Federation Attributes

From the service provider and federation surveys, most expressed a neutral view as to the adoption of new attributes. One federation respondent was positively disposed to the adoption of new attributes, whereas one limited change to additions to the eduPerson specification (they would be against changing from the eduPerson specification).
